WELCOME

Hello just a short Newsletter to promote a few events that are happening soon and a important change to the SGAP Constitution from the SGAP Secretary Pramod Mistry. The current Constitution Section K7 reads:

The management committee will be made up of the following members

- Chair, Secretary, Treasurer and up to Nine other members (including three junior members and two co-opted members) elected at the General meeting. Honorary officers (Chair, Secretary, & Treasurer) shall hold office for a maximum of TWO years from the conclusion of the meeting, after which they would retire from office, but would be eligible for election as committee members to serve for one full year before they can be re elected as officers. All other members of the committee shall retire from office together at the end of the next Annual General Meeting following the one at which they came to office but they may be re-elected . The proceedings of the Management Committee shall not be invalidated by any vacancy among their number.

The new wording will now say:

The management committee will be made up of the following members

- Chair, Secretary, Treasurer and up to Nine other members (including three junior members and two co-opted members) elected at the General meeting. Honorary officers (Chair, Secretary, & Treasurer) shall hold office for a **Minimum of ONE year and upto a Maximum of FIVE years** from the conclusion of the meeting, after which they would retire from office, but would be eligible for election as committee members to serve for one full year before they can be re elected as officers. **All members including the officers** of the committee shall retire from office together at the end of the next Annual General Meeting following the one at which they came to office but they may be re-elected . The proceedings of the Management Committee shall not be invalidated by any vacancy among their number.
